## What To Be On The Lookout For:

- Strong/strange odor. (like ether, ammonia, urine, acetone, or other chemicals).
- Windows open all day/night, even in winter
- Renters carrying in propane grill tanks, gas cans, tubing, glass canning jars, coolers.
- **Unusual traffic all hours of the day and night**
- Excessive trash (Solvent and antifreeze containers, lantern fuel cans, red-stained coffee filters, drain cleaner, batteries, and cold tablet packages)

Renters who pay only in cash

There are more than 25 toxic chemicals that can be used in cooking Meth. Each pound of Meth produced leaves 5 to 6 pounds of toxic waste behind.



If you discover a Meth lab call 911 immediately!

Never attempt to enter the site of a clandestine Meth lab.

Don't confront anyone associated with the production of Meth.
